MEMORIAL BENCHES



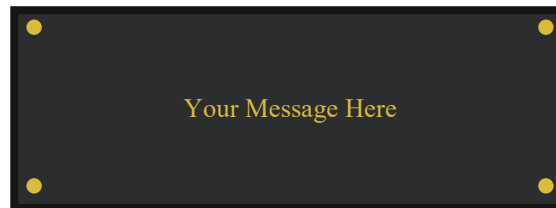
