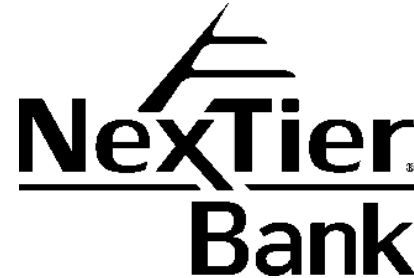

**From Kittanning:**

Take Rte. 66 South. Travel 6 miles.  
Turn left onto Crooked Creek Dam Road (SR2019).  
Travel 0.5 miles. Turn left onto Kerr Road (T670).  
Travel 0.25 miles. The ODC is located at the end of Kerr Road.

**From Leechburg or Apollo:**

Take Rte. 66 or Alt. Rte 66 North. Travel 8 miles.  
Turn right onto Crooked Creek Dam Road (SR2019).  
Travel 0.5 miles. Turn Left onto Kerr Road (T670).  
Travel 0.25 miles. The ODC is located at the end of Kerr Road.

Drop off 8:00-8:30 A.M.  
Pickup 4:00-4:30 P.M.

**About the Outdoor Discovery Center (ODC)**

The ODC is dedicated to our mission to provide an engaging experience for natural discovery through education, recreation, and outreach. It was originally built and operated by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, but is now maintained and operated by the Armstrong Center for Community Learning.

The ODC is set on thirty-five wooded acres located next to Crooked Creek Lake Park, which offers many recreational opportunities including boating, fishing, and swimming. The park also has more than seven miles of nature trails and an equine trail. The ODC maintains its own interpretive trails and herb garden as well.

The building has a large multipurpose room with a fully equipped kitchen, overnight accommodations, and a great room housing a collection of mounted animals that includes birds, mammals, fish, and reptiles.

The ODC offers programs for the public and provides environmental educational experiences. As a multiuse facility, the ODC is available to organized groups and businesses for meetings, workshops, and retreats.
